COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION RV AND BOAT PARKING LOT RESOLUTION

June 15 - Sept 15

- Boat trailers may stay all summer if it belongs to a full-time owner.
- Excess vehicles, cars or pickups, that do not fit within the confines of the assigned unit's parking area, are allowed.
- Motor Homes and Travel Trailers on a transient weekly basis only (this would accommodate visitors that happen to be travelling, Wapato as one of their stopping points)
- Full-time owners would not be allowed to park Motor Homes, Travel Trailers, Car Haulers, Snow Mobile Trailers, or the like for longer than a week (this would allow for them travelling and staying for a week). There will be no long-term parking allowed, during these months, for this type of vehicle.
- All vehicles and watercraft trailers must have a valid parking sticker or tag attached.

Sept 16 – June 14

- Any vehicle or trailer will be allowed to be stored for the full time period, as long as they are full time owners, and have a valid parking sticker or tag attached.
- Timeshare owners will be allowed to park only during their assigned week of stay

Enforcement/Fines

All watercraft, trailers, vehicles, and RVs must have visible stickers or tags issued by WPMC, at all times. Any trailer or vehicle that does not have a tag or sticker will be subject to fines, towing and impound at owner's expense. Safety Services or WPMC Staff will give a warning notice if not properly tagged or stickered. Owner's will have **48-hours** to properly tag or sticker the vehicle or trailer. If the vehicle or trailer still has not been properly tagged or stickered a **fine of \$250** will be imposed along with a **24-hour** notice to come into compliance. If after the 24-hour notice, vehicle or trailer still has not been properly tagged or stickered, vehicle or trailer will be towed at owner's expense.
